¹²We ask you, brothers, to **respect** those who labor among you and are over you in the Lord and admonish you, ¹³and to **esteem them very highly in love** because of their work. (1Thessalonians 5:12-13a)

¹⁷**Obey** your leaders and **submit** to them, for they are keeping watch over your souls, as those who will have to give an account. Let them do this with joy and not with groaning, for that would be of no advantage to you. (Hebrews 13:17)
